PINOTAGE 2012

The Fat Bastard Pinotage was made from carefully selected grapes with the aim to produce a wine with pure fruit character.

All fruit was hand-harvested and gently pressed to retain aroma and flavour. The wine was aged in small oak barrels, which added greater weight and complexity.

Pinotage, a truly South African grape, originated from a cross between Pinot Noir and Hermitage. This wine shows rich aromas of ripe plum and banana with a lingering impression of chocolate and plum pudding.
